

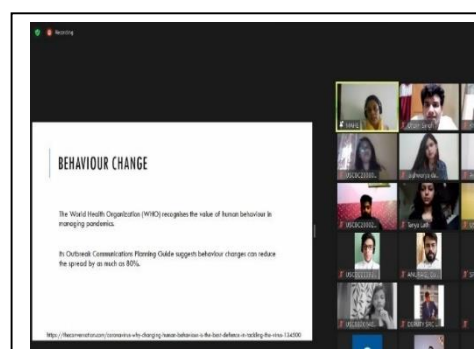
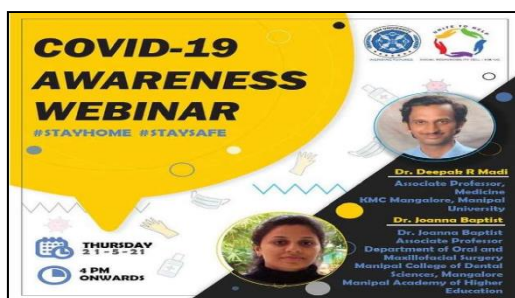
Worthy Wellness (Donation Drive) Campaign:

5. Van Mahotsav Divas:

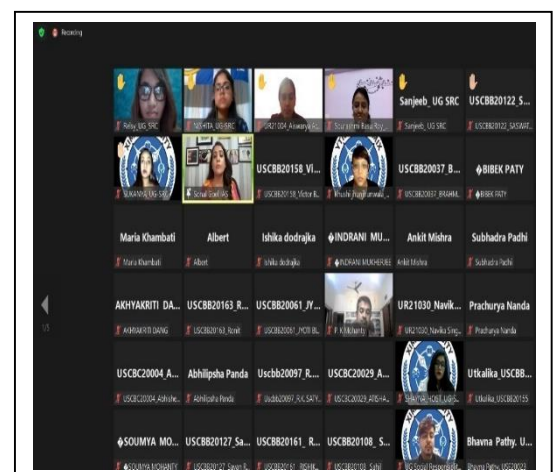
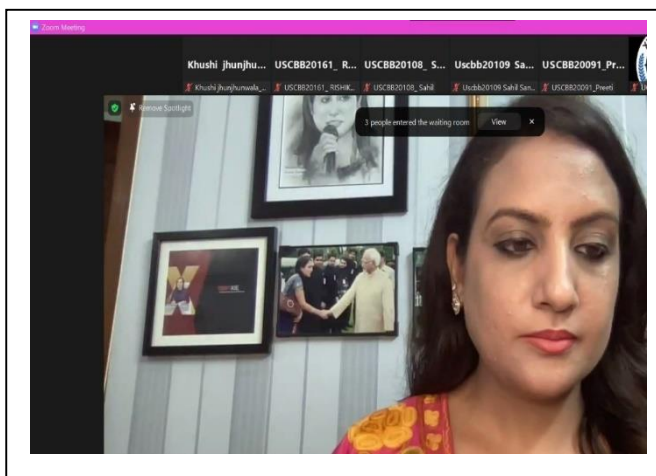

6. Webinar on Women Empowerment:

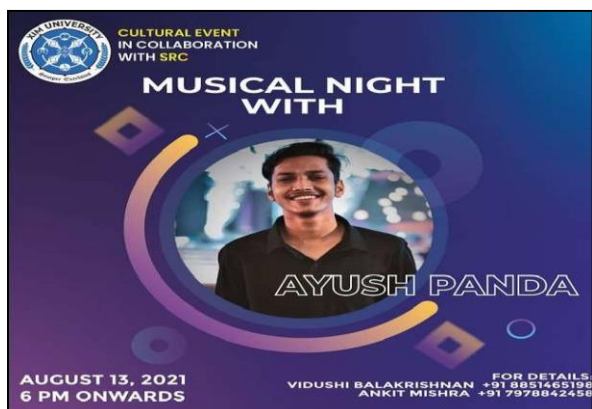

She inspired the university budding students to become better citizens tomorrow and has a long interaction. The journey was very inspiring and our students felt motivated



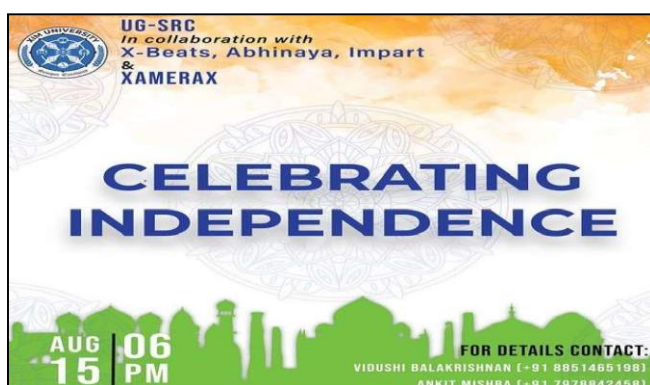
7. Musical Nights with Ayush:
