### **NSS Day Celebration**

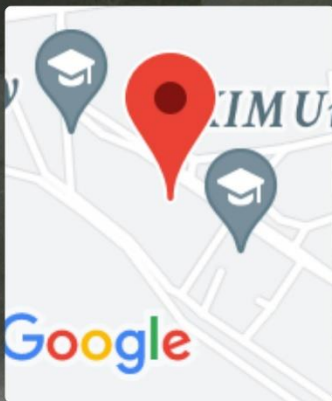
