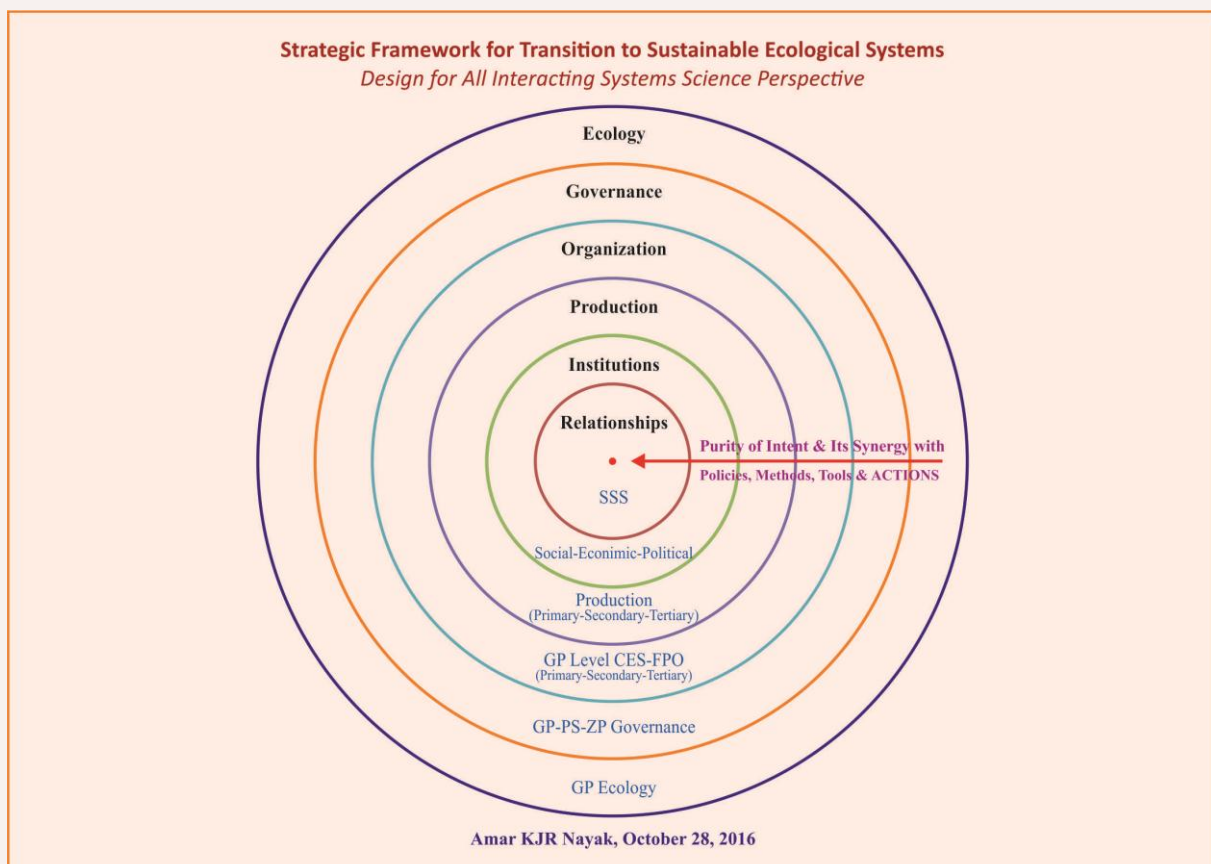

His research on sustainable ecological systems includes the dimensions of organizations, institutions, production, governance, ecology and relationships from a design and systems science perspectives. He uses multiple methodologies of research with an emphasis on Action Research in rural community systems. He has published five books, five monographs, several policy documents and over 80 research articles and cases.

He teaches and trains graduate students, doctoral scholars, development professionals, senior bureaucrats and policy executives on Research Methodologies, Competitive Strategies, Non Competitive Strategies, Leadership and Transition Strategies for Sustainable Ecological Systems from the Design for “All Interacting Systems Dynamics: Perspective”. He has been an advisor to various organizations and institutions such as Government of India, various State Governments, FAO-UN, UNDP, World Bank, NABARD, BIRD, NIAM, DMI, Corporations, Foundations, and Not for Profit Organizations. He has widely travelled to and lived in different parts of the world including Asia, Europe, North America and South America for studies, lectures, seminars and conferences.
